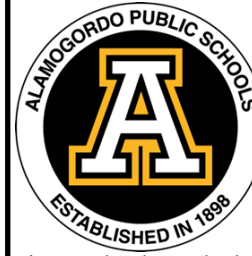

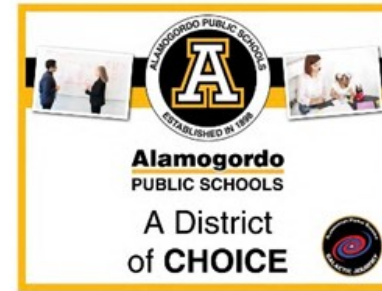

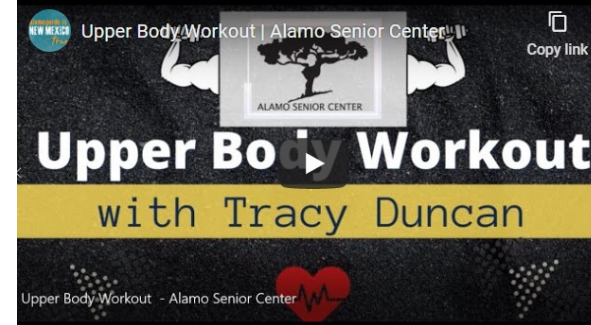


New Mexico WIC Program
